# **Policy Statement:**

Physicians Health Plan, PHP Insurance & Service Company, and Sparrow PHP will support dose rounding through the Medical or Pharmacy Benefit based on approval by the Clinical Pharmacist or Medical Director using the following determination guidelines

## **Drugs and Applicable Coding:**

#### **Clinical Determination Guidelines:**

- I. Dose rounding
  - A. Medication requests may be automatically rounded up or down by 10% in order to fit the nearest manufacturers strength of the requested medication for patients weighing > 10 Kg.
  - B. Medications with rounding otherwise specified per PHP Benefit determination policies.
- II. Wastage
  - A. Indication: Drug or biological in only a single-use vial or single-use package that remains after rounding (if applicable) & administering a dose/quantity of the drug.
  - B. Prior authorization (PA) unit calculation: Separately identify wastage/dose as well as duration of the PA
  - C. Billing: Bill the wastage separately using the JW modifier
  - D. Exclusions:
    - 1. Overfill wastage: Drug > the amount identified on the package or label
    - 2. Dose administered is < HCPCS billing unit
    - 3. Drugs available in single-use as well as multi-use vials (e.g. Herceptin)
